All short stories must be 2000 words or less. Entries above the word limitation will not be considered. Type the word count on a separate cover page along with your name, address, phone number and email address.

Do not put your name or contact information on any other page of your entry.

This competition will focus on spotlighting the work of local writers; therefore submissions will only be accepted from residents of Vancouver Island and the Gulf Islands. All entries **MUST** be previously unpublished material and not currently under consideration in any other contest or competition. We will not accept entries which have previously been entered in the Nanaimo Short Fiction Contest. Entries will not be returned.

Deadline for entries is March 1st 2012 at 5:00pm at the Nanaimo Arts Council Gallery in Nanaimo North Town Centre Mall. Mailed entries must be postmarked no later than March 1st 2012. Make cheques or money orders payable to the Nanaimo Arts Council. All entries must be typed on one side of standard 8½ x 11 paper.

Winners will be announced in April 2012 at a reception at the Nanaimo Arts Council Gallery and posted on The Nanaimo Arts Council website as well as recognized in the newsletter "The Umbrella" and follow-up public media.
